

Call for Proposals for the Joint Research Project (2024)
Joint Research Center for Immunoproteogenomics
Sapporo Medical University (SMIP)

1. Research Project

Sapporo Medical University Research Institute has been approved by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japan as one of the Joint Research Centers since 2022, promoting both domestic and international collaborative research activities. This is one of the government's projects to develop the research environment and infrastructure. We are calling for new proposals for collaborative projects in 2024. Any research project is eligible, but the research must be partially conducted at facilities of the Research Institute of Sapporo Medical University and must be approved in advance by one of the researchers affiliated with the Research Institute.

2. Eligibility for Application

Applicants must be researchers at domestic or foreign universities, research institutes, or private companies, or their equivalents.

3. Research Period

The research period should be for one year (until the end of March), and can be renewed annually.

4. How to apply

Applicants are requested to discuss in advance with the Institute's researchers with whom they intend to conduct joint research the details of the research, and apply as follows.

May 7, 2024 to May 31, 2024

6. Number of projects planned for adoption

5 to 10 projects

7. Notification of results

All applications will be reviewed by the committee and applicants will be notified by email of acceptance or rejection.

8. Joint Research Agreements

Sapporo Medical University will sign a written joint research agreement with the research institution to which the adopted researcher belongs.

9. Research expenses

SMIP will cover a portion of the expenses necessary for the research project, but no expenses will be allocated to applicants in advance.

10. Joint Research Report

Applicants for joint research are required to submit a research report after the joint research is completed. The submitted report will be published on our website, used for citation in project reports to the extent deemed necessary by our institute.

11. Publication of results

When publishing the results of the joint research, please include the following statement and submit a copy of the article or a PDF file.
